HIGH BUSH BLUEBERRY VARIETIES 2025

Mature bush 4'-6' tall and 3'-4' wide. All self-pollinating



BERKELEY:

High yield. The berries have a firm texture and a deep blue color, making them a popular choice for fresh eating, baking, and canning.

Size: Large sized firm berries *Taste:* Sweet & juicy *Ripens:* Late July

zone 4-7



BLUECROP:

High sugar content that's great for pies and preserves

Size: Medium berries *Taste:* Sweet *Ripens:* Mid July

zone 4-7



BLUEJAY:

Superb for baking and preserves.

Size: Medium to large sized firm berries *Taste:* Sweet with high sugar content *Ripens:* Late July

zone 4-7



CARA'S CHOICE:

High yield variety. Very sweet berries.

Size: Medium to large sized firm berries *Taste:* Sweet *Ripens:* Late July

zone 4-7



ELLIOT:

Produces a large harvest of berries.

Size: Small to medium sized firm berries *Taste:* Mild *Ripens:* July

zone 4-7



JERSEY:

Produces an abundant crops of large, light-blue berries.

Size: Medium to large sized firm berries *Taste:* Sweet *Ripens:* Late July

zone 4-7



NORTHLAND:

The Northland Blueberry is one of the most cold-hardy highbush varieties. This is an early-season variety, ripening in July. The medium-sized, flavorful berries of the Northland are similar to wild blueberries with a high sugar content, making them a popular choice among berry lovers. They're a delight when eaten fresh, and are preferred for jams, jellies, and sauces.

Size: Medium *Taste:* Sweet *Ripens:* July
